PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Basic Firefighter Program prepares students for the safe, dependable and prompt performance of duties in the fire station as well as in the community. It includes orientation to the fire service, instruction in fire alarms, vehicles, and apparatus and equipment. Those students who successfully complete the course may participate in the State of Florida certification examination. Certification is required in the State of Florida for employment as a Firefighter.

Special admission requirements are associated with this program.

PROGRAM LENGTH:

450 clock hours, approximately 3 months for the DAY course and 30 additional hours for testing.

PROGRAM SCHEDULE:

DAY Hours: 8:30 AM to 5:30 Monday through Friday. The schedule will be explained at the orientation session

DAY PROGRAM APPLICATION PACKET

Requirements for Consideration for Selection

ALL DOCUMENTATION MUST BE ON FILE AT PALM BEACH STATE COLLEGE ADMISSIONS OFFICE, LAKE WORTH, BY THE DEADLINE DATE.

The following criteria determine eligibility for placement in the selection pool. Meeting the criteria for selection does not guarantee admission to the Basic Firefighter Training Program. Final selection will be based on the applicant pool. If a student is selected and does not enter the program or is not selected, he/she must reapply and is not guaranteed acceptance in any subsequent selection process. **Your criteria for selection can be viewed at www.palmbeachstate.edu/pantherweb.xml under Limited Access Application Status and all communication will be sent to your my.palmbeachstate.edu e-mail account including all acceptance documentation. These criteria supersede any other information.**

1. APPLICATION

First-time Palm Beach State College Students: Submit a completed Palm Beach State College general credit application at <http://www.palmbeachstate.edu/AdmissionsApplications.xml> and pay the appropriate fee by the deadline date. This one-time fee is \$30 for U.S. citizens, \$75 (U.S. currency) for international students and is non-refundable. Be sure to insert your current and active e-mail address where requested; be specific regarding your program of study. Once submitted, a confirmation e-mail with conditions of admission will be sent to the e-mail address provided in the college application. Print the confirmation page and follow the instructions within. Applicants must also submit the program application contained in this packet and submit to the Admissions office.

Non first-time Palm Beach State College Students: Must complete the program application in this packet and submit to the Admissions office.

2. EMPLOYMENT/VOLUNTEER VERIFICATION FORM

The applicant must complete and submit the Employment/Volunteer Verification Form with Application regardless of employment status (form attached).

3. PROOF OF AGE

All students must be at least 18 years of age on or before the start of the program.

4. ACADEMIC RECORDS

HIGH SCHOOL

Transcripts must be official transcripts sent (transcripts are considered official if sent directly by mail or hand delivered in a sealed envelope directly from the issuing institution) to the **Palm Beach State College Admissions Office** showing proof of a standard high school diploma, GED, or validated foreign equivalent. All applicants – new, current, and college transfer students - must have their official high school or GED transcript on file at Palm Beach State College. You may download the transcript request form from our website at <http://www.palmbeachstate.edu/transcripts.xml>. Students who received a Florida GED can request their scores using the downloaded form at <http://www.palmbeachstate.edu/transcripts.xml>.

COLLEGE

Official college transcripts (transcripts are considered official if sent directly to Palm Beach State College from previous institution or hand delivered in a sealed envelope that is sealed by the issuing institution) from **ALL** post-secondary institutions attended must be submitted. You may download the transcript request form from our website at www.palmbeachstate.edu/transcripts.xml. All post-secondary records from out of country must be submitted with a commercial evaluation. If you have attended college, we still require proof of a standard high school diploma, GED or validated foreign equivalent. Go to: www.palmbeachstate.edu/ForeignTranscript.xml.

5. NATIONAL FIREFIGHTER SELECTION INVENTORY - TEST

All applicants must take the National Firefighter Selection Inventory – Test. You must score 70% or higher in order to be eligible to enter the program. Your scores are valid for two years. Additional Information about this test and study guides can be found at www.publicsafetyrecruitment.com. The Palm Beach State College Lake Worth book store will have the study guide in stock. The Student Learning Center (SLC) at the Palm Beach State College Lake Worth location provides Vocational Preparatory Instruction (VPI) for students who need additional skills to pass the NFSI test. For more information, please call 561/868-3795. Please note: Students with an A.A.S., A.S., A.A., or higher degree from a regionally accredited institution; students who have taken and successfully completed the College Level Academic Skills Test (CLAST); or students who have already met the minimum cut scores for placing in college level work, within the past two years, on the FCELPT, SAT1, PERT, ACT-E, are exempt from this exam and the T.A.B.E. Documentation is required. The NFSI - Test is offered at the Lake Worth, PB Gardens, and Boca Testing Centers only. There is a \$35.00 fee for this exam. Please pay the cashier and report to the Testing Center (with photo ID) to arrange to take the exam.

6. CANDIDATE PHYSICAL ABILITY TEST (CPAT)

Applicants must register for the CPAT on line at www.palmbeachstate.edu or at any Palm Beach State College location and successfully complete it prior to consideration for placement into the selection pool. CPAT scores are valid for one year prior to the application deadline. There is a \$116.83 fee for this test. CPAT information can be found at <http://www.palmbeachstate.edu/fire>. A valid CPAT Certificate will be acceptable from other providers and must be submitted prior to program deadline.

7. T.A.B.E. (TEST OF ADULT BASIC EDUCATION)*

All enrolled students that need to take the NFSI - Test must take and pass the TABE Full Battery Level (A) with a score of 10th grade level or higher in reading, language and math to be eligible to graduate. There is a \$25 fee for this exam. Please pay the cashier and report to the Testing Center (with photo ID) to arrange to take the exam. *** All applicants who have successfully completed the TABE after April 1, 2012 are exempt from taking the TABE for graduation.**

8. PREREQUISITES: Must be certified as a “First Responder,” “EMT,” or “Paramedic.”

Applicant Point System for Selection

Only one point value from each of the 4 categories will be awarded with the exception of category 3. Documentation must be provided. After all eligibility requirements for placement into the selection pool have been satisfied, the following point system will be utilized for selection into the program. All documentation must be on file at the Palm Beach State College Admissions Office, Lake Worth, by the deadline date.

If a student is selected and does not enter the program or is not selected, he/she must reapply and is not guaranteed acceptance in any subsequent selection process.

FINANCIAL AID:

At this point the program is *not* eligible for federal aid programs; however, there are scholarships available through the Palm Beach State College Foundation. A background and MVR (driving record) check is required for those individuals selected to attend the Fire Academy.

The Background and MVR Check applications and an Affirmation document will be sent along with letters of acceptance to the program. The \$30 fee will be borne by the applicant, and the results must be delivered to the Fire Academy Bureau Chief on or before the date of the Orientation session. If it is determined by the Bureau Chief that the applicant has not met the criteria set forth in the Affirmation document signed by the applicant and notarized, he/she will be found ineligible to partake in firefighter training.
