

Honors Student Advisory Board Minutes

Meeting began at 10:20am

- Jonathan Murphy, our President for the Fall 2010-spring2011 term, led the meeting. Kim the Vice President, co-led. Marina, the Secretary took minutes. Marcella, Honors College Manager was also in attendance and added input where necessary.
 - Discussed the peer mentoring program that was being developed with the help of PTK and its goals
 - Discussed the decision that the Honor's Student Advisory Council previously voted on making mandatory requirements for all Honors students to remain enrolled in the Honors College and in order to continue to receive the benefit of early registration. The new mandatory requirement approved previously by the Honors Student Advisory Council is that: All honors students must enroll in at least one honor's class (or do an honor's project) each semester. If an Honors College Student fails to either take an Honors class or complete an Honors project for two consecutive semesters, then the student may be asked to leave the Honor's college and lose Honors College benefits such as early registration.
 - A promotion card is being developed for orientation so students are made aware of the Honors College, a step to eventually phase out the certificate program now being offered to compensate for lack of knowledge of the Honors College. The first sample card was passed around - suggestions from HSAC members for the card include:
 - adding that there is an Honor's diploma/certificate, travel/conferences/scholarship opportunities available, good for networking, Face book link
 - Using short phrases rather than one word
 - It was decided to keep the cell phone symbol to scan to get information, but to move it to a lower location on the card.
 - Other suggestions the general appearance of the card, such as enlarging the font for some wording on the card, and minimizing other areas.
 - Discussed possible locations for future meeting
 - Outside area of Starbucks on Northlake (off I-95)
 - Earl of Sandwich at the Wellington mall
 - Publix meeting room on PGA Blvd
