

EVIDENCE

Each artifact constitutes **evidence** for your pre-professional teaching competency. Depending on the course and the educator skills attached to it, you will typically be working on the following **types of evidence**. There are other types of evidence, but these are the ones most frequently used in the Palm Beach State College EPI program:

- An audio or visual demonstration or **performance** (Evidence type #1)
- A written, audio or visual **product** (Evidence type #2)
- A written product used to determine student achievement (Evidence type #3)
- An analysis and results of student academic performance (Evidence type #4)
- **Professional development and service** evidence (Evidence type #5)
- A written observation or **reflection** (Evidence type #7)

You will also need to become familiar with the term **sample key indicator**. It is simply a sub-section of the evidence type you are using. Each of the 12 EAPs has its own listing of the sample key indicators. The sample key indicator for each artifact is indicated on the information sheets and rubrics which your instructor will distribute.
