

Teaching Demonstrations

One requirement of the Teacher Certification Program is to complete a successful teaching demonstration. This is typically done during the participant's final semester with the program.

1: Choose a School

If currently employed as a teacher, communicate with your school administrators and then contact our office.

If you are not a full time teacher of record, you need to match a school to the grade level / subject area in which you hold a valid Statement of Eligibility from the Florida Department of Education.

A minimum of 2 contacts with a cooperating teacher is needed before any teaching demonstration takes place.

Obtain a **Teaching Demonstration request form** at our offices in the Continuing Education building on the Lake Worth campus. There are specific forms for requesting a teaching demonstration at G-Star School of the Arts for Motion Pictures and Broadcasting (9-12), JFK Medical Center Charter School (K-5), or Poinciana Day School (K-8).

2: Choose Date(s) and Submit Information

Identify possible dates and times (give at least 3 choices) for a teaching demonstration observation and submit the information to our offices. We will arrange for an observer and communicate/confirm the arrangements.

3: Prepare a Lesson Plan

A lesson plan will need to be prepared for the demonstration. The lesson needs to be least 30 minutes.

4: Review of Teaching Demonstration

The observer will review the lesson/ observation right after the lesson in private as time permits. If you are unable to meet after the demonstration, a copy of the review will still be made available to you. A review of the Teaching Demonstration observation will also included as part of the Exit Interview.

5: Schedule Your Exit Interview

Schedule an Exit Interview.
