Justification: PLA2303: Presently Palm Beach State College does not offer any paralegal courses focused on criminal law. A course in criminal litigation will satisfy the present need for students to learn both substantive and procedural criminal law. This need was assessed through informal polling of students and educators from other competitive colleges. The Business Partnership Council and Cluster approved this course development. (Minutes indicate a "1" in the title but since PBSC does not offer Criminal Justice 2, the "1" in the title of PLA 2303 was removed per the program chair agreement.) A conversations with the Criminal Justice faculty clarified the need for this course. Both courses will remain elective options for the Paralegal AS program. Program Revision: The program needs to be revised to include the changes included in the previously submitted course revision and addition forms. Specifically, Paralegal Office Systems (PLA2762) needs to be renamed Law Office Management and the elective course selection needs to be revised to reflect the addition of Criminal Litigation (PLA2303).
