Justification: This is the initial development of courses for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing. The new Director of the BS in Nursing also reviewed the program listing and adjusted the program offerings to better fit the needs of the Nursing discipline.

Discussion: Dr. Anita Kaplan gave an overview of this curriculum action which included the development of five new courses and some revisions to the program listing. T. Fairbanks asked if those changes to the program list that affected faculty teaching assignments (i.e. the removal of CHM 1020L and SYG 2000 from the lower division prerequisite courses) were the faculty notified of these changes. K. Gamble pointed out that the BS Nursing would not be offered for the first time until January 2012 and so notification in this case was not necessary. NOTE: In general, changes to programs are done the academic year before the changes are instituted and it is the responsibility of the program initiating the changes to notify faculty of the possible changes in assignments. T. Fairbanks also asked about the reason for the changes to program listing and what research was done, specifically the removal of the SYG 2000 for the program list. Full-time BS Nursing faculty, Nancy Pfeifer-Neil explained that the curriculum was researched both in the state of Florida and nationally and reflects what was needed for the profession. Dr. Pedersen also verified that the changes made mirrored the updated state articulation for the AS in Nursing to the BS in Nursing effective July 2011. The updated statewide articulation only requires psychology (PSY 2012) rather than a choice of sociology (SYG 2000)

or psychology (PSY 2012).

<u>Justification</u>: This action will provide additional lab hours so that the students can be more proficient in their scanning skills and anatomy knowledge before entering the clinical setting. This will provide them with more learning and scanning time at the hospital settings so that they will graduate with a high proficiently level of scanning and data analyzing skills. The program listing revision does not change program learning outcomes but rather the projected start dates and course sequence of the program courses.

Discussion: Program Manager, Patty Braga, explained that on the recommendation of the program business partnership, SON 1100 Principles and Protocols of Sonography would change from a didactic course to a lab course. This coincides with the recommendation to move admitting students into the Sonography program beginning in summer term to fall term. This would give students a full term of course work prior to working in the clinical setting rather than just the two courses possible in the summer term. E. Mueller asked for clarification on the addition of "Acceptance into the Sonography program." as a prerequisite for SON 1100L. As this is a limited access program, this is a confusing statement. Patty indicated that this was just an indication of the fact that this was a limited access program and the statement itself was not needed on the course record. She also pointed out that the action should be "Change **corequisite** (not prerequisite) from SON 1311 to SON 1311, SON1614, and SON1111 (grade of "C)...)
