<u>Justification:</u> Due to decreased enrollment and retention rates a program review of the Practical Nursing PSAV program recommended the following changes: Length of program change (recommendation - 12 months rather than the current 16 months), length of courses (5 to 6 longer courses rather than 13 short courses to allow for mentoring and remediation), inclusion of the certified nursing assistant (CNA) articulated course as the foundational course for the Practical Nursing Program and inclusion of hybrid content as well as evening-weekend classes/clinical. The

recommended changes for Palm Beach State College's Practical Nursing program mimics the changes recommended by the DOE for the 2016-2017 Framework. The proposed curriculum will lead to successful student outcomes, enhanced clinical experiences, and articulation of students within the institution and between institutions.
