



STUDENT-ATHLETE CODE POLICY

- I. Philosophical Statement: At Palm Beach State College athletic participation is a privilege, not a right.
- II. Academic Expectations
 - a. Be prepared for all classes.
 - b. Arrive to class on time and do not leave early.
 - c. Treat professors and classmates with courtesy and respect.
 - d. Notify professor seven (7) days in advance when travel for competition requires you to miss class. It is your responsibility to make arrangements with the professor on makeup work.

- III. Athletic Eligibility Expectations
 - a. All athletes enrolled at Palm Beach State must maintain a minimum course load of 12 semester hours in the fall and spring semester whether in season or out.
 - b. First semester students must pass 12 hours with a minimum grade point average of 1.75, and 24 hours with a grade point average of 2.0 by the end of the summer term.
 - c. Athletic scholarships are a one (1) academic year (fall and spring semester) commitment by the institution.
- IV. Mandatory/Random Drug Testing
 - a. The College reserves the right to drug test individuals, groups and/or teams at any time.
 - b. First positive test: immediate 3 game regular season game suspension; will offer counseling at student's expense; mandatory retest within 30-40 days, as determined by the Athletic Department.
 - c. Second positive test: immediate dismissal from the team; eviction from campus-provided housing and forfeiture of scholarship (athlete will be responsible to pay scholarship back from semester of second positive test).

- V. Student Athlete Expectations
 - a. Abide by all sport specific rules/training rules as outlined by your coach.
 - b. Be courteous to and cooperate with fans, officials, opponents, community members and media personnel.
 - c. Refrain from inappropriate behavior such as: foul language, inappropriate signs, symbols, discourteous behavior and/or unsportsmanlike conduct.
 - d. Appropriate dress is expected at all times because you represent Palm Beach State at all times.

VI. Housing

- a. All student athletes on housing scholarship must pay a non-refundable maintenance fee (\$200) per student, per academic year.
- b. All student athletes are responsible for keeping their premises clean.
- c. Any damages to apartments after check-in are the student athletes and will be charged to them
- d. Alcohol or drugs on the premises are strictly forbidden!!!!
- e. Absolutely no pets!!!!
- f. No overnight guests unless specifically approved by the Head Coach of that sport.
