

**National Science Foundation Scholars  
Transferring to Florida Atlantic University**

Scholarship Continuation Criteria – Fall term 2011

1. Students transferring to FAU and considering continuing the NSF Scholarship for the third year must continue to meet all previously stated criteria for the scholarship while at FAU.
2. By July 1 NSF scholars must do the following:
  - a. Submit a notice to my office indicating intent to transfer to FAU in a STEM program and request continuation of the NSF Scholarship
  - b. Complete the 2011-12 FAFSA form listing FAU as their primary institution for financial aid purposes, but also requesting a copy of the FAFSA be sent to Palm Beach State College.
3. Complete early registration at FAU by August 1 and submit a copy of the full-time enrollment form in a STEM program to my office.
4. Within 10 days of the start of classes all scholarship recipients must submit their final FAU registration form to my office. Any deviation in courses from the STEM major must be accompanied by a written explanation.
5. Contact my office immediately informing me of any changes in full-time or any situation that would cause you to be out of compliance with the stated criteria for the scholarship.

Scholarship Funding:

1. The first week in July, this office will give the FAU Financial Aid Office a list of student names who will transfer as NSF Scholars.
2. The FAU Financial Aid Office will cover tuition and fees up to \$1,825 for the semester.
3. Books cannot be purchased through the FAU bookstore using financial aid funds. Students can apply to FAU for a book loan of up to \$500 which can be repaid from any remaining financial aid/scholarship funds.
4. If any financial aid/scholarship remains unspent a check will be sent from FAU to the student.

Scholarship Continuation Criteria – Spring term 2012

1. The criteria for spring term are similar to fall except the deadline for informing this office of your intent to reenroll at FAU is November 1, 2011.
2. Complete early registration at FAU by December 1 and submit a copy of the full-time enrollment form in a STEM program to my office.
3. Within 10 days of the start of classes all scholarship recipients must submit their final FAU registration form to my office. Any deviation in courses from the STEM major must be accompanied by a written explanation.
4. Contact my office immediately informing me of any changes in full-time or any situation that would cause you to be out of compliance with the stated criteria for the scholarship.
