



## FACIAL SPECIALIST CERTIFICATE PROGRAM



The Facial Specialist Certificate program prepares you for a career as a registered facial specialist. Facial Specialists (also known as Estheticians) cleanse and beautify the skin by giving facials, head and neck massages and by removing hair through waxing. You will learn different types of facials and spa skin care treatments as well as hair removal methods.

You will also learn the art of make-up and the color theories in relation to make-up application. Florida law, rules and regulations, sanitation and disinfection, salon management, employability skills, ethics and the science related to salon services are also taught.

This course, offered at the PBCC Lake Worth campus, can be completed in 2½ months for the daytime student and 6 months for evening students. You are not required to have a high school diploma or GED but must be 18 years of age.

Upon successfully completing state requirements in the program:

- ⇒ You are eligible to apply to the state of Florida Board of Business & Professional Regulation for your Facial Specialty Registration
- ⇒ Upon receipt of your Facial Specialty registered license, you are eligible to work in Florida salons/spas.
