



NAIL SPECIALIST CERTIFICATE PROGRAM



The Nail Specialist Certificate program prepares you to work as a nail technician. You learn the theory and then practice the competencies of manicuring, pedicuring, applying artificial nails, nail wraps, polishing and nail art. Florida law, rules and regulations, sanitation, salon management, employability skills, ethics and basic science related to grooming and salon services are also taught.

This course, offered at the PBCC Lake Worth campus, can be completed in two months for the daytime student and five months for evening students. You are not required to have a high school diploma or GED but must be 18 years of age.

Upon successfully completing state requirements in the program:

- ⇒ You are eligible to apply to the state of Florida Board of Business & Professional Regulation for your Nail Specialty Registration
- ⇒ Upon receipt of your Nail Specialty registered license, you are eligible to work in Florida salons/spas.
