If you are planning on opening your own **COMMERCIAL** Child Care center, please call the number listed to request a packet of information which includes the rules and regulations: Palm Beach County Health Department (561) 837-5942 (North & Central County area), 561-274-3187 (South County area), or 561-996-1633 (Belle Glade area).

Successful completion of the 40 hour training requirement is evidenced by passage of competency examinations with a score of seventy (70%) or better. Please keep in mind that these classes are on a first come, first serve basis. You cannot register for a class once class has started or when a class is FULL. Payment is required at the time of registration. Students will be dropped for non-payment at time of registration.

If you have completed classes at Palm Beach State College within this past year you may register online by **1)** logging onto our website at: www.palmbeachstate.edu; **2)** click on **PantherWeb**; **3)** enter your student ID and pin number; **4)** click on *Log On*; **5)** click on the add/drop link; **6)** enter the reference number of class you wish to register for; **7)** click on **add** and then **save**. You may also pay for the class by clicking on the link that reads: payment, and choose credit card. You will then be able to check if you are registered and paid, if you click on “view my schedule.”

If you are a new student to the college you may submit your **Application for Admission (not non-credit)** online as well. Please use Program Objective Code: **5373** when asked on the application. If you encounter problems, please call the Registration Department of the campus that would be closest for you.

10 Hour School-Age Appropriate Practices (HEV 0198)

Description of Course:
