

To participate in Palm Beach State College Dual Enrollment/Early Admission, high/middle school students must:

New Dual Enrollment/Early Admission Students

- ❑ Speak with your school counselor regarding eligibility for Dual Enrollment.
- ❑ If Early Admission, meet all Dual Enrollment eligibility and submit a letter of recommendation/authorization from your high school principal on school letterhead the first term.
- ❑ Go to www.palmbeachstate.edu click on “Admissions” and then “Apply Now”. Select “High School or Early Admission” on Enrollment Intention page.
- ❑ Have a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0 (Dual Enrollment), unweighted GPA of 3.2 (Early Admission).
- ❑ Have college level readiness scores in Reading, Writing, & Math. Any combination of SAT/ACT/PERT/ACCUPLACER scores if taken within the last 2 years can be used to fulfill this requirement. If you still need to meet college level readiness scores, take all or any part of the PERT at any campus testing center. (Bring PERT score sheet to your high school counselor) Students must follow the following steps:
 - Request one-time testing fee waiver at any campus Admissions/Registration counter.
 - Required to test: Government-issued photo ID or current high school photo ID.

All **new** Dual Enrollment/Early Admissions students must register for and attend a mandatory Palm Beach State College Dual Enrollment (DE) Information Session.

- Attended an info session on any campus, regardless of where you will attend classes.

Continuing Dual Enrollment Students

- ❑ Each term, students must submit the documents below to any campus Admissions/Registration counter:
 - 1) *Palm Beach State College Dual Enrollment Permission and Registration* form from the school counselor which indicates course selection(s). This form must be completed in its entirety and signed by the high/middle school principal/designee (counselor), the student, and a parent/guardian every term.
 - 2) The following must also be submitted:
 - Public school - Grades (GPA verification) ** Form must be signed by the school counselor.
 - Private school – Official high school transcript (in sealed envelope)
 - Home Education– Home Education DE/EA Legal Compliance & Eligibility Form

**HOME EDUCATION STUDENTS WILL NEED TO PROVIDE ANY TRANSCRIPTS FROM FLORIDA VIRTUAL, PALM BEACH VIRTUAL) AND/OR ANY OTHER SECONDARY OR POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTION PRIOR TO ENROLLMENT (if applicable)

- ➡ Registration form and other required document(s) must be submitted 48 hours prior to registering for PBSC classes online. Students will receive a notification at www.palmbeachstate.edu/Pantherweb under “View Notifications”.
