The unknown individuals were observed riding on the forklift; afterwards, the unknown individuals were also observed riding the Bat Wing Mover crashing into the security vehicle damaging the passenger's side bed, and facilities service vehicle damaging the driver's side rear light. Another PBSC employee found damage to the driver's side mirror on a campus pick-up truck. The estimated damage is approximately \$265.00. Campus camera checked and showed on April 9, 2017 five (5) black juvenile males were on campus from approximately 1:10 pm until approximately 1:30 pm. They approached the campus from the east side and north west side. All of the juveniles entered the facilities area. Four (4) of the juveniles scaled the fence/wall on the north side of facilities and entered the facilities area, while in the area they looked around the vehicles and buildings.
