

Jan & Gary Dario Gallery to feature works of photographer Arnold Levine Jan. 20 – Feb. 24

(Lake Worth, Fla. Jan. 3, 2011) The Jan and Gary Dario Gallery on the Palm Beach State College Lake Worth campus presents "Arnold Levine: Arrivals and Departures - A Photographic Installation," January 20 – Feb. 24.

"Arrivals and Departures" features 22 45" x 30" black and white images of Mr. Levine's 26-hour Amtrak ride from New York to West Palm Beach. This installation transforms the space of the gallery, making the viewer feel as if they are in an actual train station. Complete with constructed sets from the College's theater department, large standing photographs and an Amtrak ticket booth, this is a unique photographic display documenting the narrative of constant travelers moving quickly from one place to another.



The opening reception is from 5 to 7 p.m. on Thursday, Jan. 20 and is free and open to the public. The Jan & Gary Dario Gallery is located in the Humanities building on the northeast corner of Congress Ave. and 6th Ave. South.
