FAHRENHEIT 451 FINALE TO BE HELD AT PBCC

The countywide reading campaign that launched more than a month ago will end at Palm Beach Community College's Duncan Theatre, Thursday, April 25 with a reception and a live audio discussion with Los Angeles Author Ray Bradbury.

National Public Radio's Renee Montagne will interview Bradbury, whose 1953 science fiction classic *Fahrenheit 451* drew thousands of people into reading and discussion groups. Bradbury will take questions from the audience.
