#### **McGregor is author of textbook on digital photography**

(Palm Beach Gardens, Nov. 25, 2002) **Florida photographer Jeffrey McGregor** will exhibit his unique photographic visions at The Art Gallery at Eissey Campus Dec. 9 through Jan. 24. The **opening night reception is from 5 to 8 p.m. on Dec. 12**; the public is invited. Admission is free. The gallery is located at Palm Beach Community College in Palm Beach Gardens, 3160 PGA Blvd.

McGregor’s images represent “contemporary photo-impressionism” and are taken conventionally as well as digitally. McGregor has studied with well known Florida photographers Jack Lord, Dieter Kohn, Robert Becker, Thomas McCartney, Richard Zakia and Monte Zucker. He began teaching photography in 1980 at a local high school; popular demand for him to teach more advanced courses in photography led to the formation of the Photography Club of the Palm Beaches. He has taught evening photography classes at various educational institutions, including Palm Beach Community College. McGregor was instrumental in establishing the photography lab at PBCC in Palm Beach Gardens.
