PBCC GOLF CLASSIC SET AT THE FALLS

LAKE WORTH – Golfers have a rare opportunity to tee off at the renowned 18-hole course at The Falls Country Club, site of this year’s Palm Beach Community College Golf Classic on March 29.

Sponsored by South Florida Blood Banks, the PBCC Golf Classic is limited to just 120 players. The event will open with registration and lunch beginning at 11:30 a.m., followed by a 1 p.m. shotgun start. A post-play reception and live auction will round out the day.

Players may register as foursomes or individuals. A variety of sponsorship opportunities also are available.

The Falls, located at 6455 Jog Rd. in Lake Worth, is a private facility open to only a few charity events each year. The Joe Lee-designed course measures 6,820 yards from the championship tees and plays to a rigorous slope of 132. Its serene waterfall view and signature 16th hole make it a memorable as well as challenging course for golf enthusiasts.
