## **Palm Beach Community College names new vice president of student services**

(Lake Worth, Fla. – June 13, 2006) Dr. Quincy L. Moore has been named the new vice president of student services at Palm Beach Community College.

He was appointed by President Dennis P. Gallon after an extensive nationwide search. Moore will begin his new position July 10. He comes to PBCC from West Chester University in Pennsylvania where he has served as dean of undergraduate studies and student support services since 2001. Prior to that, he served in several administrative positions at Virginia Commonwealth University, Clark County Community College and the University of Nevada-Las Vegas.

Moore has more than 20 years of senior student development management experience and a passionate commitment to assist students in becoming lifelong learners. "I try to help students realize that every day is a learning experience," said Moore, who has developed more than 50 papers, presentations and workshops on issues dealing with student success and student retention. He currently is writing two books titled "The Disappearing Educated Black Male" and "Mentoring from a Conceptual Framework."

A Chicago native, he holds a bachelor's degree in business administration, sociology and psychology from Culver-Stockton College, a master's degree in guidance and counseling from the University of Nevada and a Ph.D. degree in counselor education from the University of Iowa. He was selected to participate in the Management Development Program (MDP) for advanced studies at Harvard University.

Among his numerous awards, Moore received the "African American of the Year Award" for outstanding achievement and leadership from the African American community of Las Vegas. In 2005, he received the David K. Brooks Distinguished Mentor Award from the American Counseling Association. He also was honored in 2005 by the president of the Association for Multicultural Counseling and Development, a division of ACA, with the Presidential Award for Distinguished Service to the Division.
