PBCC film students to compete internationally in 48 hour film competition

(July 19, 2006 – Palm Beach Gardens) When Friday at 7 p.m. July 28 rolls around, groups of filmmakers in the Miami area will spring into action. Twelve students from the Motion Picture and Television Production Technology program at Palm Beach Community College in Palm Beach Gardens will participate for the first time in the 48 Hour Film Project. The winning film will compete with other 48-hour films from around the world.

Teams will be asked to write, shoot and edit a short film between Friday and Sunday nights.
