Construction graduates ready to make their dreams come true

(May 22, 2007 –Belle Glade)- Tool belts overflowing with tools, hard hats, work clothes' vouchers, OSHA cards and certificates are the material items that Palm Beach Community College's Introduction to Construction graduates were given during a celebration in their honor at the Belle Glade Elk's Club on May 10.

While their training and these items gave the students all that they need to find entry-level employment in the construction field, it is those things that cannot be seen or touched that will have the biggest impact on the 30 graduates' lives.

Through classroom lectures and hands-on projects, the students became proficient in the essentials of the labor construction field. During the 168-hour course, they developed skills in safety, hand tools, power tools, construction math, blueprints, basic rigging, masonry, carpentry and plastic pipe fitting.

These newly gained skills both increase the graduates' earning power as well as their confidence. Many of the students, either unemployed or underemployed, are now qualified to find positions working on the many construction projects underway in western Palm Beach County.

The course, offered through a partnership with Associated Builders and Contractor's Institute, is part of a grant that the college received from the South Florida Water Management District to provide job training and workforce development opportunities to residents of the Glades to prepare them to work on the Comprehensive Everglades' Restoration Project.
