Notre Dame professor to discuss globalization during lecture at Palm Beach Community College

(Palm Beach Gardens, Fla. – Feb. 18, 2008) Dr. Lee A. Tavis, a University of Notre Dame business professor, will discuss globalization during a lecture at Palm Beach Community College in Palm Beach Gardens March 13.

Presented by PBCC and the University of Notre Dame Alumni Club of the Palm Beaches, the 9th annual lecture event titled “Globalization: Its Driving Force and Long Reach” will be held at 7:30 p.m. in the Meldon Lecture Hall, 3160 PGA Blvd. It is free and open to the public.

“Globalization is an issue that impacts all of us. Nations are linked economically to a larger extent than ever before in history,” said Thomas Magill, a PBCC adjunct professor of economics and a Notre Dame alumnus who is coordinating the event with Associate Dean Samuel Freas. “Dr. Tavis’ talk will add to our understanding of our world.”



Tavis is the C.R. Smith Professor and Director of Notre Dame’s Program on Multinational Managers and Developing Country Concerns. His research focuses on business planning models and the potential contribution of multinational firms for development in Africa, Asia and Latin America. Before joining the Notre Dame faculty, he was professor of finance at the University of Texas, research coordinator for the International Center for the Advancement of Management at Stanford University, an associate consultant for McKinsey and Company and a United States Navy aviator.
