PBCC achieves eight national rankings in degrees, certificates awarded

(Lake Worth, Fla. – June 18, 2009) – Palm Beach Community College earned high national rankings in eight categories in *Community College Week's* “Top 100 Associate Degree Producers” listings.

The publication analyzes U.S. Department of Education data to develop its annual lists, examining two- and four-year colleges that award the most degrees and certificates.

The rankings released June 15 and based on 2007-08 data, place PBCC in the top 50 in seven categories, including:

- 6th in the nation in associate degrees in liberal arts and sciences, general studies and humanities, with an 11 percent increase in those graduates over 2006-07.
- 15th nationally in the awarding of associate degrees in all disciplines.
- 30th in awarding associate degrees in nursing, reflecting a 57 percent increase in graduates.
- 42nd nationally for conferring associate degrees in health professionals and related clinical sciences.

With an increasingly diverse student population at PBCC, associate degrees in all disciplines conferred to non-minority, African-American and Hispanic students also grew. Among non-minority students, PBCC ranked 18th with a 6 percent increase. The College also ranked 18th for degrees conferred to African-American students, based on an increase of 13 percent from the previous year, and 31st for degrees earned by Hispanics, reflecting a 26 percent increase.

Graduates in one-year certificate programs in all disciplines increased by 18 percent, earning PBCC a 51st ranking in that listing.

The strength of Florida's community colleges was evident in the *Community College Week* rankings, with seven of the top 15 associate degree producers in all disciplines located in the Sunshine State.
