

“Abstract Connections” features ceramic art

(Nov. 20, 2003 – Palm Beach Gardens) Ceramic artists Bryan Hiveley and Bonnie Seeman will display their work Dec. 8-Jan. 22 in an exhibition, “Abstract Connections,” at the Art Gallery at Eissey Campus, Palm Beach Community College.

Both artists teach in South Florida as well. Hiveley is on the faculty of the Miami International University of Art and Design, and Seeman is a full-time lecturer at the University of Miami.

Nature is the inspiration for Bryan Hively, who conveys its beauty and intelligence by suggesting universal biomorphic forms in his abstract work. He focuses on obvious natural wonders as well as what seems to be insignificant in a reexamination of the natural world. Hively’s work has been shown nationally and featured in national ceramics publications.

Bonnie Seeman was chosen in 2001 as an emerging artist by the National Council on the Education for the Ceramic Arts. She has exhibited her work nationally, and this year it was shown in Basel, Switzerland and Madrid. Her work has been featured in numerous publications and museum collections.
