10/22/09-FYI-TABE/VPI Project and Action Plan-The addition of VPI0100, VPI0200 and VPI0300 as corequisites for Trade and Industrial PSAV program courses effective January 2010 has been reversed for now. It has been determined that the programs are not ready to monitor this addition this Spring term to their course programs to promote students to take the required TABE exam and remediate in order to complete these programs as prescribed by state statute. Justification: In a review of programs offered at PBCC, several programs were discovered not to meet SACS requirements for AS degrees. Some programs also had confusing listings for students that needed to be clarified. Since it did not have an AAS option, the Landscape and Horticulture Management AS degree needed to remove the option of a non-General Education Math (MAT 1033) as a General Education choice for this AS program. The Crime Scene AS program also needed to remove MAT 1033 as the selection for a General Education selection for this AS program and also the clarify that a Humanities General Education selection was required and not an option with a Natural Science or Social Science selection. The latter action allows this program to meet SACS General

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Education requirements minimum for an AS degree of 15 credits of College Composition, General Education Mat or Science, Social Science, Speech and Humanities. All of these are now included in the Crime Scene Technology AS degree as well as HSC 2100.

Discussion: Janette Campbell brought up issue with limiting the General Education Mathematics to MAC 1105. When researched, it was discovered that this was an error and should read **"Any course from Mathematics-Area III."** This correction was sent out to the committee and they were requested to revote if this change affected their original vote. No one changed their vote.
