An emergency curriculum vote for processing was approved by Dr. Ginger Pedersen on behalf of VPAA Dr. Sharon Sass [Verbal Verification] June 4, 2012.

This change was not reflected in the Area of Study and Catalog General Education Course Listing for Natural Sciences Area III which still lists the lab as “optional.” This has been changed and will be included in a catalog addendum.

School Age Professional Certificate (PSAV) Articulation- Dr. Sass approved the internal articulation of this PSAV certification for 3 college credits toward the Human Services-Youth Development Concentration specifically for HUS 1620-Principles and Best Practices in Afterschool Programs. This action was effective January 2012 and the appropriate forms will be posted online.
