ITEM 2. Departmental Exams to Replace State Exit Exams

Discussion: EAP Final Exit Exam

Action:

The cluster will set up a drop box where faculty and adjuncts will create a library of exams enabling the cluster to have access to reading, grammar, and writing exams to determine whether common exams can be utilized as potential exit/final exams within all the EAP levels. Using these exams, the EAP cluster will create standardized Exit Exams for all EAP levels. These tests will be required by all adjuncts but will be optional for full-time faculty. Tests will be piloted by the summer of 2012 provided classes are being taught to pilot such tests.

ITEM 3. PERT EAP Cut Scores

Discussion: EAP members brought up that EAP-1584 and EAP-1520 students were misplaced and should have been placed into EAP-0460 and EAP-0420.

EAP-0460 (50 to 71) EAP-0420 (50 to 68) EAP-1584 (72 to 89) EAP-1520 (69 to 83)
