## ITEM 1. Blackboard and the SLC

Jim Robinette and Jesse Rogers

Discussion:

Jim provided a handout that explains common student issues with blackboard. He emphasized the importance of identifying from general student complaints just exactly what kind of problem the student is experiencing. For example, access problems could be due to the student is using the wrong password, because of passwords that are more than 6 characters (although we believe this issue should now be resolved), the student's payment has not yet been processed and they should allow 24 hours. Jim also discussed course specific issues, browser issues, and computer skill issues in the context of both student and instructor errors. Although Lyam was unable to attend because he was in another meeting, he relayed a question to Jim regarding whether blackboard courses could be set up as tool to provide SLC resources to non-distance learning students, specifically in reading. Jim indicated this would be a director level decision, but that the first thing his director would want to know is where the money would be coming from for this, since blackboard charges the college based on the number of accounts. He suggested the creation of learning objects, and teaching students how to use POLO as an excellent alternative. In answering other questions, Jim discussed the rapid growth of eLearning at the college, and his optimism for the partnership with the SLC, which includes helping us to be familiar with the answers to common student questions.
