ITEM 2. Assignments Linked with the Learning Outcomes (LO)

Discussion: A representative from each sub-committee presented on the status of the assignment. Most sub-committees are still in the information collection stage.

- a) LO #1 Engage in our college culture and utilize academic resources
 - Emphasize the importance of learning HOW to find the resources, not just what the resource is
 - Establish a set of core questions to be used by all campuses and then tailor the remaining questions based on campus resources
 - Monica to send out the document for those who want to pilot it this fall
 - Students could complete this during the Computer Lab Orientation or at home
 - Share your ideas with Monica and Pam
- b) LO#2 Explore and research career options
 - Most campuses use a combination of Career Center Orientation, O'Net Career Assessment, and research project
 - Some faculty also have students contact a Career Mentor
 - Share your ideas with Joyce, Jeannette, and Jyrece

- c) Establish an educational plan
 - Most campuses use a pre-Orientation assignment, Orientation with an Advisor, and creation of an education plan (most using the interactive educational planning tool in Pantherweb)
 - Assignment should contain a retention/completion goal (end goal with anticipated graduation date)
 - Assignment should include planning beyond one or two semesters (to help students complete their education plan online before they complete 30 credits)
 - Share your ideas with Manny, Karline, and Mark H.
- d) Develop and strengthen academic skills
 - Proposed assignment will be revised to allow faculty to choose the assigned reading (chapter) to use to complete the assignment
 - Additional ideas for study strategies are needed
 - Share your ideas with Sandy, Marc D., and Sophia
