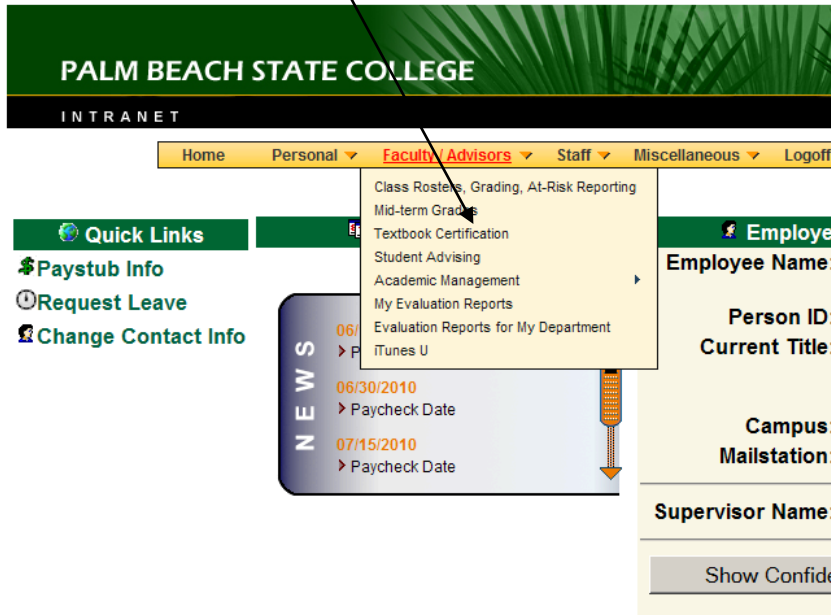

1. **Sign on to EmployeeWeb** – Go to www.palmbeachstate.edu/employeeweb - and sign on using your user id and password. If you do not know your user id or password, please contact the Help desk (helpdesk@palmbeachstate.edu).

Instructions:

The Higher Education Act of 2008 by the federal government contains several provisions regarding textbook affordability. In response to this act, the Florida Legislature enacted statute 1004.085, Textbook Affordability. In response to this statute, Florida Administrative code rule 6A-14.92 was developed. To be in compliance with statute and rule, a committee of faculty and administrators designed an online form. This form will allow faculty to attest that all items students are required to purchase are used in class (including all items in a "bundle") and the extent to which a new edition differs significantly and substantively from earlier versions. 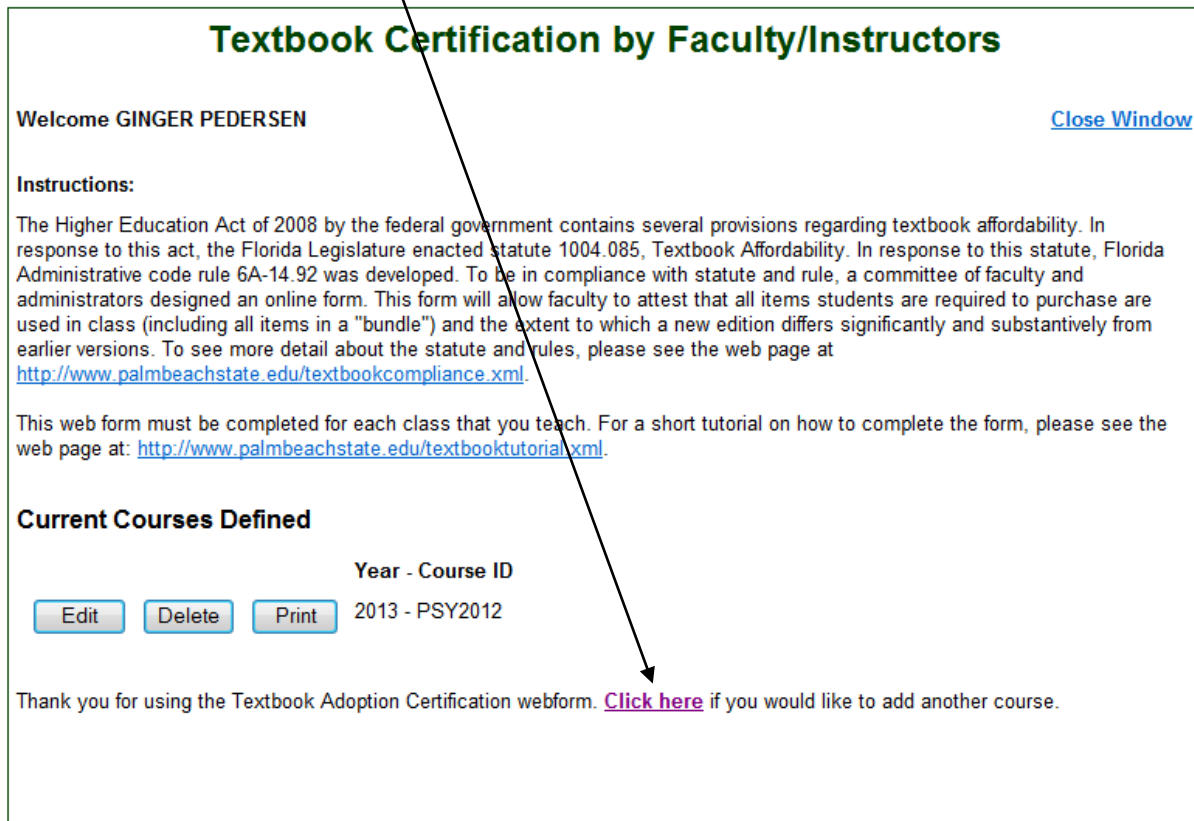
