Approval of Region XII Criminal Justice Training Council Meeting Minutes – December 12, 2013

Chief Mangold asked Council for approval of the December 12, 2013 minutes. Motion for approval by Chief Jenkins seconded by Chief Hartmann. Minutes were approved.

Legislative Updates and CJSTC Rule Changes – Joni Livingston

- *No rule changes to discuss.*
- *2 courses updated to align with statutes, both for civilians, parking enforcement and selective traffic enforcement program.*
- *Attorneys are very familiar with all CJSTC requirements for speed measurement training and are using this information to win in court. Remember, speed measurement cannot be taught in-house, must be at a CJSTC training center*
- *Governor has put in the \$67.00 per officer in the budget but this will still require legislative approval.*
- *Agencies need to know when applicants started their academy to ensure they are within the 4 year window for eligibility.*

- June 30th everyone needs their firearms qualification on the CJSTC course.

Criminal Justice Institute Update – Director Larry Schroeder

- Audit was less than perfect. Issues with 2 recruits in the corrections academy being allowed to take a re-test when they were both ineligible. Both students returning to retake defensive tactics and a waiver will be submitted to the CJSTC at the May meeting concerning their state officer certification examinations. Some other minor errors were identified and all have been corrected.
- State Officer Certification Examination is now available online at PBSC. Students can take exam within days of completing the academy, and receive their results immediately. Official test results are reflected in ATMS
- PBSC is offering a course in SUIDS based on changes in the law, course would be pertinent to both EMS as well as law enforcement personnel. Need to determine if this could be done utilizing TrainU, director to follow-up.
- 2 full time and 2 part time law enforcement academies are in session.
- A full time corrections academy begins March 20th
- A Corrections to Law Enforcement Cross-Over academy begins March 11th
- Initial discussions with PBSO for an all PBSO Corrections Academy for late summer
- Explained that the council also serves as our Business Partnership Council
- The college will be closed for spring break March 3 – 7.

Region XII Trust Fund Report – Director Larry Schroeder

- This portion of the audit was perfect.
- All required reports have been submitted.

Advanced/Specialized Training – Director Larry Schroeder

- Will be seeking input for training needs for the upcoming fiscal year based on the proposed return to \$67/officer funding level. Will host a meeting and let the chief's know (copy email) so they can ensure attendance.

Selection Center Updates – Director Larry Schroeder

- May academy already closed for applications but some slots are available for agencies should the need arise.
- We continue to offer six law enforcement academies per year
- There are differences between academy entry requirements and agency/statutory employment requirements which allows academies to include folks who potentially will not be employable.
- One appeal.
