Part I: Rules and Regulations - Center Based (Total hours: 6) - HEV0114

This course fulfills Part I of three parts required to complete the 40—Hour Introductory Child Care Training mandated by the Department of Children and Families (DCF) for child care workers.

***FL Res. Fee: \$26.68 / Non FL Res. Fee \$66.46**

***Book: Child Care Facility Rules & Regulations \$19.50**

Part II: Introduction to Child Care Worker Certification (Total Hours 24) - HEV0115

This course fulfills Part II of three parts required to complete the 40—Hour Introductory Child Care Training mandated by the Department of Children and Families (DCF) for child care workers.

Part III Appropriate Practices (UDAP + one 5– hr Course OR one 10 hr course)

(Total Hours 10)

These courses fulfil the third part of the required 40-Hour Introductory Child Care Training mandated by the Department of Children and Families (DCF) for child care workers.

Option 1-Select one UDAP course + one (1) of the three (3) 5-hr age specific appropriate practices.

Part 1: Understanding Developmentally Appropriate Practices (UDAP)

Part 2: Choose one (1) of the three (3) hour 5-hr age specific courses (HEV0001, HEV0002

or HEV0003)

HEV0001-Infant/Toddlers Appropriate Practices- is required for Florida Child Care

Professional Credential (FCCPC) Program (Birth-3 Years Old)

HEV0002-Preschool Appropriate Practices- is required for Early Childhood Professional

Credential (ECPC) Program (3-5 Year Olds)

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HEV0003-School Age Appropriate Practices-is required for School Age Professional Certificate (SAPC) Program (5-12 Year Olds)

***FL Res. Fee: \$23.90 / Non FL Res. Fee \$64.55 *Book: Preschool Appropriate Practices 3-5 years \$18.00**

Option 2: HEV0123 Special Needs Appropriate Practices (10 Hours)

HEV0123 is required to complete the Director's Credential

Developmentally appropriate practices for children with special needs is the topic of this 10-hour component.

***FL Res. Fee: \$37.80 / Non FL Res. Fee \$119.10 *Book: Special Needs Appropriate Practices \$19.00**

Part 1: Rules and Regulations - Family (HEV0118) This course is designed to give family child care providers, substitutes and informal providers an overview of the state and local rules and regulations that govern the childcare industry. (This course replaces the three-hour fundamentals of Family Child care.) The goal of this course is to ensure that family child care professionals recognize the primary laws which govern child care in Florida and understand the role of the regulatory agencies that enforce those laws.

***FL Res. Fee: \$26.68/ Non FL Res. Fee \$75.46 *Book: Family Child Care Home Rules & Regulations \$19.25**

Part I - School Age Program Certification (HEV0803) This course will focus on State rules and regulations; health, safety, nutrition; identifying and reporting child abuse; and school age appropriate practices. Part I requires that the participant pass a competency exam with a score of 70% or higher given by Department of Children & Families. (DCF)

***FL Res. Fee: \$87.84/ Non FL Res. Fee \$315.48 *Book: Part I School-Age Certification \$61.25**

Part II - Foundations of Advancing Youth Development (AYD) Principles (HEV0804) This course will introduce the participant to a specialized school age curriculum Advancing Youth Development (AYD) Principles and requires that participant pass a competency exam in class with a 70% or higher.

100% Attendance is required.
