#### IMPORTANT REMINDER

International students must have funds on deposit and withdrawable from U. S. banks or other sources to cover all living and educational expenses for a minimum of one year. These funds must also be available on a continuous basis to ensure adequate financing during the student's entire educational stay in the United States.

No financial aid is available to international students, although limited funds are sometimes made available through the Financial Aid Office.
