4. Operation

4.1 Operator Qualifications. An automotive lift operator shall have the following qualifications:
 (1) ability in written or oral communications as demonstrated by one of, or a combination of, the following: high school diploma or certificate of equivalency, aptitude test or job experience;
 (2) ability to understand the mathematical, mechanical and electrical principals of automotive lifts as demonstrated by one of, or a combination of, the following: aptitude test, training program, technical-vocational school, school of higher learning or job experience;
 (3) demonstrated physical ability to carry out lift operator responsibilities in a safe manner.

4.2 Operator Training

4.2.1 The owner or employer shall ensure that operators of automotive lifts are instructed in the safe use and operation of the lift using the manufacturer-provided instructions and warning labels and the Automotive Lift Institute publications, "Quick Reference Guide, Vehicle Lifting Points for Frame Engaging Lifts" "Lifting It Right" and "Safety Tips".

4.2.2 ANSI/ALI requires the lift manufacturer to supply operating instructions, general safety information, safety tips and warning labels with each lift manufactured. The owner or employer shall display these materials in a conspicuous location in the lift area.
