### The following items are **NOT PERMITTED** in the Test Room

<b>Outerwear (coats or jackets)</b>	No outerwear can be worn in the testing room. This includes overcoats, windbreakers, down jackets, rain jackets/slickers and so on. Clothing that is part of an outfit that would typically be worn indoors, including sweaters, sweatshirts and blazers are allowed. If the item has pockets, you must show that the pockets are empty.
<b>Hats, hairbands, etc.</b>	No hats of any kind or other head coverings are allowed inside the testing room except for religious or medical reasons.
<b>Cell phones or pagers</b>	Cell phones and pagers must be turned completely OFF before placing them in the locker.
<b>Purses, wallets and watches</b>	All purses, wallets, watches and large jewelry must be placed in the locker.
<b>Hand-held computers, personal digital assistants, or any other electronic devices, including (but not limited to) USBs, Google Glass, camera glasses, etc.</b>	All items (except medical devices) must be turned OFF and placed in the locker.
<b>Briefcases, backpacks or bags</b>	If the item is too big for the locker, place all valuables in the locker. Backpacks and briefcases can be stored on the bookshelf.
<b>Calculators</b>	No Nspire calculators or calculators with internet access.
<b>Pens and pencils</b>	Only writing instruments supplied by the test center are allowed.
<b>Food or drinks</b>	Students are NOT permitted to bring food or beverages into the testing room. Water bottles ONLY may be stored on the bookshelf.
