Celebrated by both The Grammy Foundation and The National Endowment for the Arts with Lifetime Achievement Awards, inducted into the Gospel Music Hall of Fame, and winners of five GRAMMY® Awards, they have attained the highest levels of recognition.

Mariachi Herencia de Mexico

Mariachi Herencia de Mexico, a youth ensemble from Chicago's immigrant barrios, is mariachi music's most exciting newcomer. Their debut album, "Nuestra Herencia" (Our Heritage) released in May 2017 hit #2 on the iTunes Latin chart, defying a music industry trend and pointing to a revival in recorded mariachi music. The album scored a Latin Grammy nomination. Their follow-up album, "Herencia De La Tierra Mia" (The Heritage Of My Land) debuted at #2 on the Billboard charts and at #1 on the iTunes charts. Mariachi Herencia de Mexico can hold their own with the best mariachi groups in the world, having performed alongside major artists like Lila Downs, Aida Cuevas, Los Lobos, Pedro Fernández, Mariachi Vargas de Tecalitlan, Los Camperos, Sol de Mexico, Cobre, and the all-female group Reyna de Los Angeles.



As part of the Smithsonian's Think Water Initiative, the exhibit raises awareness of water as a critical resource for life. "Water/Ways" explores the endless motion of the water cycle, water's effect on landscape, settlement and migration, and its impact on culture and spirituality. It looks at how political and economic planning have long been affected by access to water and control of water resources. Human creativity and resourcefulness provide new ways of protecting water resources and renewing respect for the natural environment.

The exhibition is part of Museum on Main Street, a unique collaboration between the Smithsonian Institution Traveling Exhibition Service (SITES), Florida Humanities and Palm Beach State College's Glades Campus/Dolly Hand Cultural Arts Center. 
