MUSIC COURSES AT PALM BEACH STATE COLLEGE

MUSIC ENSEMBLES

Music Ensembles at Palm Beach State are classes (1 credit). They are open to all students (music majors, other majors, part-time students, etc.). Up to four (4) credits of MUN courses can be used towards completion of an Associate of Arts degree at Palm Beach State.

Chorus (MUN 1310) - Mondays & Wednesdays at 11:00-12:20

- Chorus is a large vocal ensemble (25-40 members) which performs choral literature from the medieval and renaissance period through contemporary compositions. No audition required

Concert Band (MUN 1120) – Monday evenings from 7:00-9:00

- Concert Band is a large instrumental ensemble (30-45 members) which performs standard band literature from the Renaissance period through contemporary compositions. Audition required

Brass Ensemble (MUN 1430) – Offered occasionally based on student interest

- Brass Ensemble is a chamber ensemble (4-10 instrumentalists) which performs standard brass literature.

Jazz Combo (MUN 1710 C) – Tuesday & Thursday afternoons (time varies)

- Jazz Combo is a small ensemble (4-8 musicians) which performs classic jazz compositions and standards from the American songbook. Audition required

Tuesday Nite Band (MUN 1710 D) – Tuesday evenings from 7:00-9:00

- The Tuesday Nite Band is a medium-sized big band (14-18 instrumentalists) which performs advanced jazz literature encompassing a variety of styles. Audition required (available to advanced level Palm Beach State students)

Jazz Guitar Ensemble (MUN 1710 E) – Tuesdays & Thursdays at 5:00-6:20

- Jazz Guitar Ensemble is a small ensemble (6-10 instrumentalists) which performs classic jazz compositions and standards from the American songbook. Audition required

Beginning level instruction – Group Classes

- MVK1111A – Class Piano 1. Group instruction in piano for beginning level students

Intermediate to advanced level instruction (aka Applied lessons) – Individual Instruction

- Applied lessons are available to music pre-majors and other students who meet the requirements
- Participation in a music ensemble and Recital Seminar is a requirement
