## **Merz Trio**

Praised for their "fresh and surprising interpretations," the award-winning Merz Trio are known for their passionate playing and uniquely artistic programming style, interspersing classic trio works with interdisciplinary elements and their own arrangements. Recent debut appearances include performances at NYC's Merkin Hall, Boston's Isabella Stewart Gardner Museum, and the Concertgebouw in Amsterdam.

## **Telegraph Quartet**

The Telegraph Quartet (Eric Chin and Joseph Maile, violins; Pei-Ling Lin, viola; Jeremiah Shaw, cello) formed in 2013 with an equal passion for the standard chamber music repertoire and contemporary, non-standard works alike. Described by the *San Francisco Chronicle* as "...an incredibly valuable addition to the cultural landscape" and "powerfully adept... with a combination of brilliance and subtlety," the Telegraph Quartet was awarded the prestigious 2016 Walter W. Naumburg Chamber Music Award and the Grand Prize at the 2014 Fischhoff Chamber Music Competition.

## **Baldourdet Quartet**

The Balourdet Quartet, based in Boston, is currently in residence at the New England Conservatory's Professional String Quartet Program. The group received the Gold Medal in the 2020 Fischhoff National Chamber Competition, the Gold Medal and Audience Award at the 2021 Chamber Yellow Springs Competition, and the Second Prize in the 2019 Carl Nielsen International Chamber Competition.
